Music 130 Piano Class I 1 Semester Hour

Description

Piano Class I provides instruction in elementary piano techniques and music reading skills. This course is offered once a year (spring or fall).

Overall Objectives

Upon successful completion of this course, the student will be able to

- 1. Demonstrate familiarity with the piano keyboard.
- 2. Read beginning level piano music with moderate fluency.
- 3. Perform simple transpositions.
- 4. Harmonize simple melodies.
- 5. Sight-read level-appropriate pieces.
- 6. Perform simple improvisations.
- 7. Perform selected major and minor scales, chord progressions, and arpeggios.
- 8. Recognize selected key signatures.
- 9. Play selected solo and ensemble pieces.

Major Topics

- 1. The piano keyboard
- 2. Reading music notation
- 3. Music vocabulary and terminology
- 4. All five-finger positions
- 5. Scales, progressions, and arpeggios
- 6. Simple transposition, harmonization, and improvisation.
- 7. Sight-reading
- 8. Solo and ensemble repertoire.

Course Requirements

- 1. Regular and punctual class attendance
- 2. Effective use of class time and individual practice time
- 3. Sufficient practice in preparation for each class

- 1. This course is required for all music majors whose major instrument is not piano.
