Description

HORT 233 - 3 credits – Landscape Design Studio provides individual critiques on various landscape designs; expand on landscape design principles learned in Basic Landscape Graphics (Hort 107) and Landscape Design (Hort 230)

2 credits; 2 laboratory hours per week.

Prerequisite: (RDNG 051 or LVR 1), HORT 107, HORT 230, or consent of instructor

Overall Course Objectives

Upon completion of this course the student will be able to:

1. draw landscape designs applying the basic principles and theory of landscape design;
2. interpret landscape designs and design process verbally in clear, concise language;
3. respond to critique questions using proper principles and theory of landscape design; and
4. transfer landscape design from paper to the ground.

Major Topics

- I. Applying the basic principles and theory of landscape design
- II. Presenting the principles of landscape design through the use of landscape drawings
- III. Presenting a design process for each landscape design and interpreting verbally in a clear concise language
- IV. Interpreting landscape drawings and locating the design on the ground
- V. Using library resources to complete course assignments

Course Requirements

Grading/exams: Grading procedures will be determined by the individual faculty member, but will include the following:

1. Weekly Critique of Landscape Designs
2. Attendance and Participation
