Common Course Outline ANET 203 Anesthesia Technology Practicum I 5 Credits

Description

ANET 203 – Anesthesia Technology Practicum I provides the student with the opportunity to apply theoretical knowledge in the clinical setting under the supervision of a preceptor. This course offers the opportunity for hands on experience with anesthesia equipment, its setup and maintenance.

5 Credits: 15 clinical hours per week

Prerequisites: ANET 101, ANET 102

Overall Course Objectives

Upon completion of this course students will be able to:

- 1. independently create a comprehensive anesthesia care plan;
- 2. apply theoretical knowledge of the role of anesthesia technologist in the care of patients in general and outpatient operating room patients;
- 3. identify potential hazards that may impact patient safety;
- 4. demonstrate appropriate infection control practices;
- 5. perform effective communication skills within the interprofessional team;
- 6. perform therapeutic communication skills with patients;
- 7. demonstrate proper storage, categorization and ordering of medications;
- 8. function as part of the anesthesia and operating room team;
- 9. demonstrate proper preparation of anesthesia equipment and maintenance; and
- 10. apply critical thinking in troubleshooting equipment.

Course Requirements

An overall grade of C (70%) or higher is required for satisfactory completion of the course.

Grading procedures will be determined by the course faculty members but will include the following:

Graded by using a clinical evaluation tool

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Clinical Requirements:

- Attendance at all assigned clinical experiences
- Satisfactory performance in the clinical experiences

Written Assignments: Students are required to utilize appropriate academic resources.

- Minimum of one writing assignment such as: anesthesia individualized care plan or a paper on a topic relevant to the course.
- Citations are based on the American Psychological Association (APA) format.
