Description

CONT 104 – Construction Craft IV: Construction Craft IV is awarded after the completion of a three, four, or five-year Craft Apprenticeship program. provides for the awarding of articulated credits after completing a craft apprenticeship program, which complies with approved standards set by the Maryland Apprenticeship and Training Council or other apprenticeship governing boards. The class is to recognize the work completed in the fourth year of the apprenticeship program.

Pre-requisites: The student must have completed a Craft Apprenticeship recognized by approved standards set by the Maryland Apprenticeship and Training Council or other apprenticeship governing boards.

Overall Course Objectives

Upon completion of this course, students will be able to:

1. The student will have completed the requirements of the fourth year of a craft apprenticeship program.

Course Requirements
