- 3. Use the terminology of poetic analysis
- 4. Express their interpretations of poems in oral form
- 5. Express their interpretations of poems in written form
- 6. Demonstrate a familiarity with diverse poets
- 7. Demonstrate a familiarity with various trends in poetry
- 8. Understand and apply various theories of poetry
- 9. Access and apply relevant literary criticism found in traditional sources and through the Internet
- 10. Work collaboratively on questions and problems related to the poetic texts

Major Topics

- Poetry from a variety of historical periods
- Poetry from different cultures
- Critical theories for interpreting poetry
- Elements of poetry

Course Requirements

- Oral participation in class discussion
- In-class writing
- Oral presentation
- At least two papers, at least one of which requires the use of secondary sources
- At least one exam with an essay component
