## Common Course Outline HORT 181 Cooperative Education I: Horticulture 1 credit

# The Community College of Baltimore County

#### **Description**

**HORT 181 – 1 credit – Cooperative Education I: Horticulture** provides the student with academic credit for knowledge and skill outcomes derived from a planned work experience in the student's chosen career field; provides entry-level career-related experience and workplace competencies that employers value when hiring new employees.

#### Prerequisites: ENGL 051, RDNG 051, MATH 081

#### **Overall Course Objectives**

Upon completion of this course the student will be able to:

- 1. participate in the job search process;
- 2. apply appropriate workplace behaviors in a professional setting;
- 3. demonstrate knowledge and skill appropriate to job assignment related to program of study and career goals;
- 4. evidence increased content knowledge gained through practical experience related to program of study and career goals;
- 5. evaluate the co-op experience in terms of their personal, education and career needs; and
- 6. describe heightened sense of identity and connection to society.

#### **Major Topics**

Co-op learning objectives are individualized and are developed cooperatively by the student, faculty coordinator, and work supervisor. Once the student has been placed with an employer, he/she will formulate tentative learning objective with the assistance of the faculty coordinator. Learning objectives must describe the activities (tasks) that the student will learn and perform on the job. The student must state specifically WHAT he/she will be able to do at the end of your work experience period, as a result of the co-op placement.

#### **Course Requirements**

The student's final grade will be based on four components:

- 1. Employer's Mid-Term Evaluation
- 2. Employer's Final Evaluation
- 3. Accomplishment of co-op learning objectives
- 4. Related departmental assignments (student projects, weekly logs)

### **Other Course Information**

This course is an elective in the Horticulture Program and is not required for the Horticulture A.A.S. Degree.
