Description

NAST 273 – 3 Credits –Native American Studies Internship is a prearranged, planned learning experience with a specific, Native-centered organization. This internship offers students the opportunity to work with specific agencies that work with Native people, communities, and nations. The Internship is non-paid and students must complete 115 hours.

3 Credit Hours

Prerequisites: NAST 127 and permission of the coordinator

Overall Course Objectives

Objectives of the internship are dependent on the location of the internship. The program coordinator, the site supervisor, and the student will work together to determine the overall objectives for the internship.

Major Topics

Major topics of the internship are dependent on the location of the internship. The program coordinator, the site supervisor, and the student will work together to determine the major topics for the internship.

Course Requirements

<u>Grading/exams</u>: Grading procedures will be determined by the individual faculty member but will include the following:

- 1. Regular attendance by the student at the internship site.
- 2. At least two evaluations by the site supervisor.
- 3. Weekly written reflection journals.
- 4. Weekly meetings with supervising faculty member.
- 5. Documentation of at least 115 hours at the placement site signed by the site supervisor.
- 6. A reflection paper summarizing the internship.
