Description

RTTT 208 – 3 credits – Clinical Education IV provides students with culminating experiences and opportunities to combine comprehensive responsibilities of an entry-level radiation therapist.

3 credits; 360 clinical hours

Pre-requisites: RTTT 206; Admission to the Radiation Therapy Program; this course is

only offered in the spring semester

Co-requisites: RTTT 129, RTTT 204 and RTTT 214

Overall Course Objectives

Upon completion of this course the student will be able to:

- 1. demonstrate a leadership role in ensuring high-quality patient care;
- 2. perform all aspects of treatment delivery;
- 3. assist with all aspects of simulation;
- 4. appropriately review patient charts for treatment changes, consent, pathology, etc.;
- 5. explain treatment procedures;
- 6. demonstrate effective communication with patients, staff, etc.; and
- 7. refer patients and their family members to the appropriate professional when advice or intervention is required.
